

What to look out for at Pomona

Things may look a little different next time you visit the Pomona station and pedestrian crossing. Please familiarise yourself with the new station features below, and follow these simple rules to stay safe around the rail network:

- pay attention to warning signs and signals
- never enter a pedestrian crossing if the red lights are flashing or solid, or the alarms are sounding
- always look for additional trains and check the 'Another Train Coming' signal is not lit up before crossing
- tune out distractions when you are crossing - such as headphones and mobile phones
- remember high voltage can jump, so keep well away from overhead power lines.

New Pomona pedestrian crossing

Monday 3 February 2020

The Pomona pedestrian crossing, just north of Pomona station, plays a significant role in connecting the local community.

Following feedback received in 2017, Queensland Rail committed to upgrading the crossing to suit community needs.

From **Monday 3 February 2020**, the upgraded pedestrian crossing will become fully operational and include the following new features (see images overleaf):

- a stop and go pedestrian signal
- a new flashing sign to alert pedestrians of another train coming, when there is already a train within the station area
- a new pedestrian maze which caters for horse riders, mobility scooters and cyclists
- signage to instruct horse and bicycle riders to dismount prior to crossing and a height gauge to ensure rider safety
- a new concrete path which connects with Pomona station carpark and Station Street
- lighting along the entire length of the new path
- fencing on both sides of the crossing.
